Vendors must supply their own water and/or grease waste bins. Garbage will be collected by SEWAPCS.

All vendors are required to submit a \$100, refundable deposit with their application. The deposit will be refunded after full payment is received. **Please make a check out to the Southeast Wisconsin Antique and Collectibles Society and include it with your application.**

PAYMENT

All vendors agree to pay 10% of their total gross income to the SEWAPCS by show close on September 8, 2024. The deposit will be deducted from the total payment. A club member will collect payment at the closing of the show. No refunds for no shows or partial attendance.

PARKING

Supply trailers will be assigned a separate parking space depending on the location of booth. No camping is allowed in these trailers/locations.

The SEWAPCS strives to maintain a product balance throughout the grounds and encourages new concessionaires to bring in products and/or services. The previous year's concessionaires, who leave in good standing, are invited to return.
