

Pulling Rules & Regulations

1. Farm tractors only, no load RPM not to exceed factory rating. Original equipment mandatory(hood, fuel tank, fenders, fan or factory housing, working governor, etc).
2. Tractor may pull in more than one class.
3. No rear weights more than 24” behind center hole in hook-up point. No front weights more than 24” in front of tractor.
4. Draw bar height must be a maximum 20” Solid draw bar hook-up mandatory. No hooks to 3 point or quick hitches. Driver must furnish their own twisted clevis for pulling. For more info see the hook dimensions flyer.
5. Driver pulls at their own risk. Driver must be 16 years of age. 16-17 year old drivers must have written permission from parent or guardian.
6. No first puller option in all classes.
7. Driver must remain seated at all times or face instant disqualification.
8. Second chance pull if sled is stopped within 50 feet.
9. Driver is disqualified if anything falls off the tractor while hooked to the sled.
10. If tractor goes out of bounds, pull will be measured from that point.
11. TIP OVER BARS ARE ENCOURAGED
12. Be safe and have fun!
