

Hook Dimensions

Are you planning to pull at our "Fall Harvest Days" pull at the Racine County Fairgrounds on September 7th? Be sure the hitch(twisted clevis) on your tractor is compatible with the large sled specifications. Your hitch(twisted clevis) must be 3 3/4 inches long by 3 inches wide to accept the hook on the sleds.

THIS MEANS IF YOUR HITCH(twisted clevis) HOLE IS NOT 3 INCHES WIDE X 3 3/4 INCHES DEEP. THE HOOK WILL NOT GO IN YOUR HITCH(twisted clevis)HOLE, AND YOU WILL NOT BE ABLE TO HOOK TO THE SLED! THIS RULE APPLIES TO FARM TRACTORS & ANTIQUES. THE HOOK WILL NOT BE MODIFIED TO ACCOMMODATE YOU!

We want to emphasize that this rule is in place to prevent accidents from happening. It is a non-negotiable part of the sled operator's insurance policy that has been in place for many years. If you have successfully hooked to a large sled before, you will be good to pull. There is no need to spread rumors or make this a big deal. Please refer to the pictures for more details.
