Dear Antique Machinery Enthusiast,

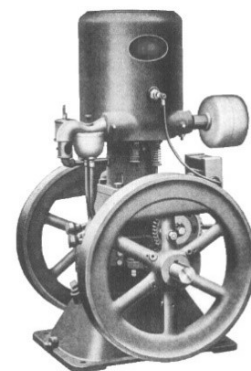

This year's feature of Engines and Orphan Tractors has a special bonus. For each feature display item that is brought to our show for display, the exhibitor will receive one ticket for a \$200 prize to be awarded Sunday afternoon after our Raffle Drawing. Exhibitors will also be granted free admission to the Show for themselves and an assistant.

- Stationary engines were once the powerhouse of farms and industry. Before electricity was widespread the stationary engine allowed farms and industry to operate equipment and machinery without the need to have it connected to a water wheel or windmill. Stationary engines ranged in power from fractional to hundreds of horsepower, and were adapted to nearly every task imaginable. We eagerly welcome any and all Hit & Miss, Throttle Governed, and early small engines up to 1970.
- Orphan Tractors are those brands which were produced, and then simply faded away. Racine once had the Wallis and Haas Tractor companies. Other more known examples are the 'Silver King', Sheppard, Empire, Heider, and Eagle tractor brands. There are many others, too.

In addition to the show, the Society will be hosting a Banquet on Friday evening that will also feature a small auction. Cocktails are served at five PM, and dinner starts at six. Reservations for the Banquet are requested to be received by August 20th.
